New York-based architects and high-rise experts Kohn Pedersen Fox are responsible for that they themselves have dubbed “a vertical complex city”. In addition to the luxury hotel, China’s tallest building is home to a variety of amenities, such as media center, an observatory, offices and a rich mixture of restaurants. It truly is a vertical city in its own right. In the same way that Kohn Pedersen Fox are skyscrapers experts, Taiwan-born Tony Chi is among the best in interior design. Based in New York, his trademark elegant simplicity is evident in the Park Hyatt Shanghai, where he has used earthy tones and luxurious materials to create an atmosphere of exclusivity. The exceptional character of the interior is reflected in the kitchens, using bulthaup b3, in the suites and the private restaurant on the 93rd floor. The openness and “floating” look of bulthaup b3 echo the spectacular views over the ever-changing big city.

The Majesty Mansion project was constructed on the Pacific coast of the Chinese port city of Qingdao, near the Peninsula Business Center. The location of the complex couldn't be better-nestled between a beautiful natural landscape on one side and the infrastructure of the city on the other. The 80,000 square meter site is home to three buildings shaped like sails, with a total area of 140,000 square meters. The lower portion of each tower is dedicated to high-end stores, while the upper floors are residential. The steel and glass façade boasts full-length windows that provide breathtaking views and let in an abundance of natural light. Premium materials and surfaces and high-quality natural stone floors are fitted with utmost precision, lending the residences a luxurious look and feel. Thirty-one bulthaup b3 kitchens with free standing islands perfectly complement the exceptional residences.
